



Wood's Edge Equestrian Center Summer Horsemanship Camps

- All abilities welcome! Camps are geared toward beginner or intermediate riders ages 6 – 14. Campers will be grouped by age and ability. PATH Intl. Certified Instructors on staff to accommodate campers with special needs. All campers must be able to use the restroom without assistance.
- Camp times are 9am to 3pm Monday – Friday each week. Each camp day will include barn activities, crafts and a horsemanship and riding lesson.
- There will be a horse show on Friday afternoon! Families are welcome to come and watch!
- A daily snack and water will be provided. All campers must bring their own lunch and a refillable water bottle is recommended. A refrigerator and microwave are available. Please label all lunches and water bottles.
- Hard sole shoes with a heel are recommended. Long pants i.e.: jeans/leggings/riding pants are required to ride and are the most comfortable to ride in; a change of clothes is recommended if camper needs/wants to change while not riding. Riders can bring their own helmet or one will be provided.
- Camp fee is \$350.00 per week. \$25 discount if paid in full by May 1, 2019.
- 10% discount to second child in the same family. (Only one discount may be applied per camper)
- Please complete and sign the attached form and submit a 50% deposit to reserve your spot. Deposits are refundable up to 30 days before camp start date. If cancellations are made within 30 days of camp start date, deposit will be forfeited. Final payment is due on the first day of camp.
- Camp space is limited so reserve your spot early!

K.S.A. Sect. 60-4002 et seq. (1994)
WARNING

Under Kansas Law, there is no liability for an injury to or the death of a participant in domestic animal activities resulting from the inherent risks of domestic animal activities, pursuant to sections 1 through 4. You are assuming the risk of participating in this domestic activity.

Inherent risks of domestic animal activities include, but shall not be limited to:

- (1) The propensity of a domestic animal to behave in ways, i.e., running, buck, biting, kicking, shying, stumbling, rearing, falling or stepping on, that may result in injury, harm, or death to persons on or around them;*
- (2) The unpredictability of a domestic animal's reaction to such things as sounds, sudden movements and unfamiliar objects, persons or other animals;*
- (3) Certain hazards such as surface and subsurface conditions;*
